 proficiency goals from student meeting standards based on MCA Test Scores, Graduation rates and

 levels of proficiency: Unsatisfactory, Satisfactory, and Exemplary that you can find in the March 30th

- Research Decision Making and Practice Profile Introduction
 - Discussion of Interventions
 - Kristil introduced a wide variety of intervention examples for school wide interventions and strategies for staff to implement in the classroom
 - Kristil shared an article about implementing interventions called 'Never Say Anythinga Kid Can Say!' that discusses school improvement over time.
 - S.T.E.A.M. concepts blended with instructional strategies has been a beneficial strategy for a school wide implementation.
 - Peer Partners discussed- Teachers could observe and evaluate each other and check for implementation of interventions- Teacher Talk*
 - Practice Profiles- FOCUS Team needs to narrow down 3-4 categories- Examples provided- Academic Talk- Intentional Questioning

- Practice Profile needs to have:
 - 'Desired Outcome'
 - o 'Instructional Strategies or Practices'
 - 'Core Characteristics'
 - 'Rubric' to rate the level of achievement for teachers demonstrating these interventions
